

Health care provider identifies, at birth or up to 1 year of age, an infant affected by prenatal substance exposure.

Health care provider makes an immediate Notification of a Substance Affected Infant (SAI) is made to Childline (via self-service portal or hotline)

Based on identified substance and potential of additional safety and risk concerns, the notification is processed as a **General Protective Services (GPS)** referral or an **Information Only (IO)** referral.
Both referral types are transmitted to the County Children & Youth Agency

Definition: "Affected by" refers to an infant with detectable physical, developmental, cognitive, or emotional delay or harm that is associated with maternal substance use or withdrawal, as assessed by a health care provider".
