



#### CHC Monthly Enrollment by Zone and MCO









The NFI population continues to account for the majority of the population at 61.4%, this was a small decrease from January. The percentage of HCBS participants increased to 28.5% from 28.4% for the previous month. The LTC population decreased by .01% to 10.1%.

#### Statewide LTSS Population and HCBS Percentage






#### Medicare Type for All CHC Participants by Region\*\*



In February, the statewide percentage of non-duals remained the same at 9.2%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs remained the same at 12.9%, and the percentage of participants in unaligned D-SNPs increased from 34.0% to 34.4%. The percentage of participants in FFS Medicare decreased from 31.5% to 31.1%. Other Medicare Advantage increased by 0.1% to 11.1%.

#### Medicare Type by CHC Zone and Plan




#### D-SNP Enrollments by Plan


#### Number of Personal Care Homes and Assisted Living Facilities by County




#### Other OLTL Program Enrollment
